



Union School District Teacher Leaders

Mathematics, ELA, ELL and Technology Teacher Leaders are instructional leaders who foster development and growth of curricular initiatives at the school site. In collaboration with the principal, school leadership, and district leadership, Teacher Leaders support the goal of building staff capacity to meet school goals and increase student learning.

English Language Arts Teacher Leader

Teacher Leaders assume a variety of responsibilities in supporting school staff that include:

- Must attend mandatory 1 ½ hour bi monthly ELA Leadership meetings facilitated by the Department of Educational Services to plan staff development and analyze data (6 hours total; schedule attached)
- Must present information formally and periodically to staff and report back to ELA Leadership team
- Must attend a mandatory Edusoft training and Leadership Coaching workshop

Additional responsibilities may include (additional 20 hours):

- Support school staff in the implementation of the district adopted Language Arts program
- Collaborate closely with the school site administrator to analyze data and plan monthly staff development
- May provide formal and informal staff development related to both research and practice for classroom teachers
- May conduct demonstration lessons, observations, and provide specific feedback to teachers (release time may be provided)
- May assist school in providing parent education related to the language arts program
- With ELA Leadership team, develop and revise district-wide benchmark assessments
- Provide teachers with supplemental resources to support ELA instruction
- Identify needs and advocate for teachers' concerns relative to initiatives of the Educational Services Department in the areas of ELA and writing
- Participate in SCCOE's Curriculum Leadership Council

English Language Learner Teacher Leader

Teacher Leaders assume a variety of responsibilities in supporting school staff that include:

- Must attend mandatory 1 ½ hour bi monthly ELL Leadership meetings facilitated by the Department of Educational Services to plan staff development and analyze data (6 hours total; schedule attached)

- Must present information formally and periodically to staff and report back to ELL Leadership team
- Must attend a mandatory Edusoft training and Leadership Coaching workshop

Additional responsibilities may include (additional 20 hours):

- Support school staff in the implementation of ELL curriculum
- Collaborate closely with the school site administrator to analyze data and plan monthly staff development
- May provide formal and informal staff development related to both research and practice in the area of working with second language learners for classroom teachers
- May conduct demonstration lessons, observations, and provide specific feedback to teachers (release time may be provided)
- May assist school in providing parent education related to the English Language Learner.
- Provide teachers with supplemental resources to support ELL instruction
- Identify needs and advocate for teachers' concerns relative to initiatives of the Educational Services Department in the areas of ELL.
- Assist with the assessment and placement of new students,
- Oversee recertification procedures
- Facilitate tracking of reclassified students.....

Mathematics Teacher Leader

Teacher Leaders assume a variety of responsibilities in supporting school staff that include:

- Must attend mandatory 1 ½ hour bi monthly Mathematics Leadership meetings facilitated by the Department of Educational Services to plan staff development and analyze data (6 hours total; schedule attached)
- Must present information formally and periodically to staff and report back to Math Leadership team
- Must attend a mandatory Edusoft training and Leadership Coaching workshop

Additional responsibilities may include (additional 20 hours):

- Support school staff in the implementation of the district adopted Mathematics program
- Collaborate closely with the school site administrator to analyze data and plan monthly staff development
- May provide formal and informal staff development related to both research and practice for classroom teachers
- May conduct demonstration lessons, observations, and provide specific feedback to teachers (release time may be provided)
- May assist school in providing parent education related to the mathematics program

- With Mathematics Leadership team, develop and revise district-wide benchmark assessments
- Provide teachers with supplemental resources to support mathematics instruction
- Identify needs and advocate for teachers' concerns relative to initiatives of the Educational Services Department in the area of mathematics
- Participate in SCCOE's Curriculum Leadership Council

Stipend

Teacher Leaders who fulfill the aforementioned responsibilities will earn a \$1,000 stipend for the school year.

Technology Leader

Teacher Leaders assume a variety of responsibilities in supporting school staff that include:

- Must attend mandatory 1 ½ hour bi monthly Technology Leadership meetings facilitated by the Department of Educational Services to modify the technology plan as appropriate, plan staff development and develop hardware and software standards
- Must present information formally and periodically to staff and report back to Technology Leadership team
- Must attend a mandatory Edusoft training and Leadership Coaching workshop

Additional responsibilities may include (additional 20 hours):

- Support school staff in the implementation of the district adopted technology plan
- Collaborate closely with the school site administrator to provide staff development
- May provide formal and informal staff development related to both research and practice for classroom teachers
- May conduct demonstration lessons, observations, and provide specific feedback to teachers (release time may be provided)
- May assist school in providing parent education related to technology
- Provide teachers with supplemental resources to support the use of technology in the classroom.
- Identify needs and advocate for teachers' concerns relative to initiatives of the Educational Services Department in the area of technology

Stipend

Teacher Leaders who fulfill the aforementioned responsibilities will earn a \$1,000 stipend for the school year.
